Many of you may not know that Washington & Lee contributes some \$27,000/year to our club. In return, we provide a practice facility for the men's and women's golf

teams as well as for a few physical education classes.

It is with the pride of an alumnus that I report the following result of that practice. Washington and Lee University sophomore Brian Peccie won the individual title and the Generals placed second in the NCAA Division III Men's Golf Championship in Greensboro, N.C. Peccie's win was W & L's first individual national championship in golf. As a team, the General produced the highest finish in program history.

May was a little uncooperative but we continue to try and improve course conditions. We apply a growth regulator monthly on the fairways to help slow down the growth. I wish we could use it in the rough but the chemical won't work on tall grass.

Late in May, the cart path work was completed on the front nine. Some ruts remain that should lessen with continued mowing. Let's use those paths, especially when parking around the greens and tees.

We also got our last piece of capital equipment, another tractor pulled rough unit that will allow us some flexibility in getting through the roughs.

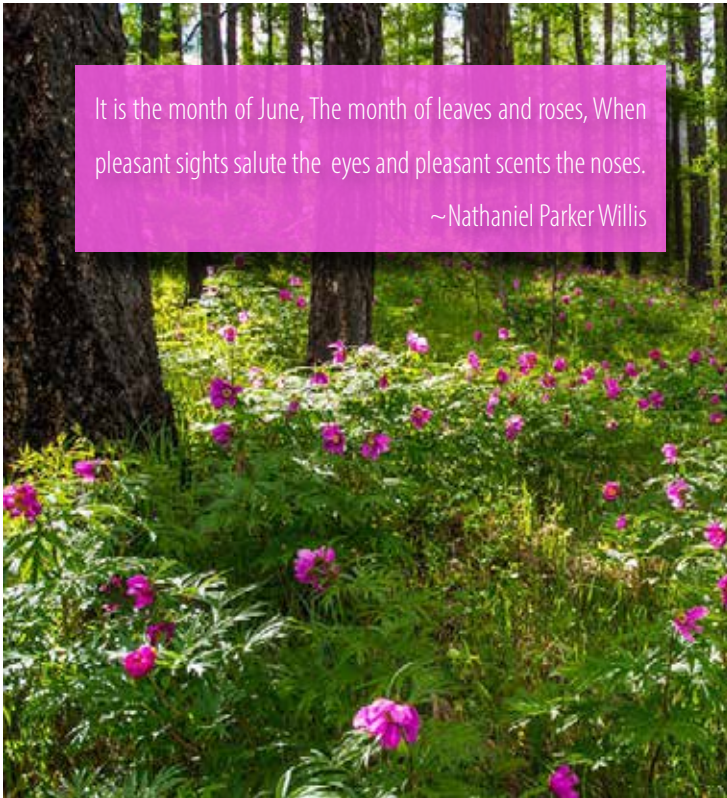
