FROM THE SUPERINTENDENT

We did a slicing (using bayonet tines on our aerifier) operation on Monday 6/25 to all our greens. This work helps our greens make it through the summer by providing channels for water infiltration and gas exchange. We can usually see some beneficial changes within a week as new white roots start to grow into the voids. We are scheduled to do this work every two weeks through August, but we may alter the work based on events. Please check with the golf shop to verify the work.

With all the rainy days we are getting a bumper crop of weeds, especially goosegrass and some sedges. We will do some spraying to try and keep these in check. Once the weeds get to a certain size they become very difficult to control. The amount of chemical required to control older plants increases and this can have a detrimental effect on our desired grasses. We take all this into consideration when planning our work to give everyone the best playing conditions possible.

Don't wait until it gets too hot! We would love to see you out here playing some golf.

BAKING TEMP VS. SIZE

The smaller the item, the higher the baking temperature. For example, I bake mini chocolate chip cookies at 500 degrees F for only 4 minutes. Better end result.



ADDING OIL TO PAN

If you find you need more oil in the pan when sautéing, add it in a stream along the edges of the pan so that by the time the oil reaches the ingredient being cooked, it will be heated.
