February continued to be sloppy and wet. When the crew came back we had to pick our spots on what work we did so as not to make a bigger mess on the course. Hopefully March gives us some relief. One big task if the weather cooperates we will be spot spraying to control broadleaf weeds and applying a growth regulator to the fairways and adjacent roughs to help with the Spring surge of growth.

We spent some time in late February recycling and discarding the 20 year accumulation of "stuff" between #7 and #9. That area certainly looks a lot better.

Greens aerification starts April 1st. We will have a modified opening schedule that week mostly related to weather. Please call the Golf Shop for more info.

I am working with Hal Hill and his gang to get a list of things on the course where we can use some help. We don't discriminate based on age so any younger volunteers are also welcome!
